This resume is an abridged version of my CV and includes a short bio. It breaks down my career into four sections: 1) Constellation Chor; 2) Composing and Performing; 3) Awards, Residencies, Grants and Discography; and 4) Education

MARISA MICHELSON is a singer, improviser, educator, and composer of Musicals, Choral Works, and Music-Theatre.

She is an active and accomplished somatic voice practitioner, performer, and composer with extensive experience in: private studio teaching (over 17 years), with many successful students on Broadway and pursuing other careers in voice; forming and maintaining groups, including *Constellation Chor || an immersion in voice, movement and spirit*, and Core Sounding™, a practice and process for improvisation; and composing, with compositions and musicals which have received substantial grant funding and critical praise.

Constellation Chor has been in residence at the historic Judson Memorial Church, Spectrum and Pioneer Works. The *Chor's* collaborators include Claire Chase, Sarah Hennies, Ash Fure, the New York Philharmonic, the Kitchen, Heartbeat Opera, Harvard Art Lab, Maria Popova, Paola Prestini, and Sara Serpa (among others). Marisa's compositions have been called "exquisite" (*The New York Times*), "otherworldly" (Steven Suskin), "gorgeous...adventurous" (Vox Magazine). Her off-Broadway musicals include *Tamar of the River* (Prospect Theater; two Drama Desk Nominations) and *One Thousand Nights and One Day* (Prospect Theatre, ART NY). *Naamah's Ark*, her oratorio for five choirs starring Victoria Clark (River to River festival in Rockefeller Park) was conducted by Ted Sperling. *Awards & grants include*: Jonathan Larson Award, National Endowment for the Arts, New Dramatists, The Foundation for Contemporary Arts, the inaugural Eric Salzman Award for Music-Theater, the Lower Manhattan Cultural Council. *Residencies include*: National Sawdust, MacDowell, Ucross, Modern Accord Depot, Blue Mountain Center, New Dramatists. Marisa lives, works and teaches singing in New York City and Hudson, NY.
